Nux vomica-Homaccord Oral Drops

Read all of this leaflet carefully because it contains important information for you.

Nux vomica-Homaccord is available without a doctor's prescription, for you to treat a mild illness. Nevertheless you still need to use Nux vomica-Homaccord carefully to get the best results from it.

- Keep this leaflet. You may need to read it again.
- Do not share Nux vomica-Homaccord with any other person.
- Ask your pharmacist if you need more information or advice.
- You must see a doctor if your symptoms worsen or do not improve.

1. What Nux vomica-Homaccord contains

Nux vomica D2 0,2 ml; Nux vomica D10 0,2 ml; Nux vomica D15 0,2 ml; Nux vomica D30 0,2 ml; Nux vomica D200 0,2 ml; Nux vomica D1000 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D2 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D6 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D10 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D15 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D30 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D200 0,2 ml; Bryonia cretica D1000 0,2 ml; Lycopodium clavatum D3 0,3 ml; Lycopodium clavatum D10 0,3 ml; Lycopodium clavatum D30 0,3 ml; Lycopodium clavatum D200 0,3 ml; Lycopodium clavatum D1000 0,3 ml; Citrullus colocynthis D3 0,3 ml; Citrullus colocynthis D10 0,3 ml; Citrullus colocynthis D30 0,3 ml; Citrullus colocynthis D200 0,3 ml.

The other ingredients are: Ethanol 96%, Purified water.

Contains 35% v/v ethyl alcohol.

2. What Nux vomica-Homaccord is used for

Pharmacological classification: D. 33.2. Homeopathy.

Discipline of the medicine: Homeopathy.

This medicine is prepared in accordance with homeopathic principles and is proposed for use in functional disorders in the gastrointestinal and hepatic region; meteorism; disorders after consumption of alcohol, coffee or nicotine.

3. Before you take Nux vomica-Homaccord

Do not take Nux vomica-Homaccord:

If you are hypersensitive (allergic) to active substances or any of the other ingredients of Nux vomica-Homaccord.

Pregnancy and Breastfeeding:

If you are pregnant or breastfeeding your baby while taking this medicine, please consult your doctor, pharmacist or other healthcare professional for advice.

Important information about some of the ingredients of Nux vomica-Homaccord:

This preparation contains only very small amounts of alcohol per unit dose. Still, it is recommended that alcoholics consult with a health professional before taking this preparation.

A temporary aggravation of the existing symptoms is possible after taking a homeopathic preparation.

Taking other medicines with Nux vomica-Homaccord:

If you are taking other medicines on a regular basis, including complementary or traditional medicines, the use of Nux vomica-Homaccord with these medicines may cause undesirable interactions. Please consult your doctor, pharmacist or other healthcare professional for advice.

4. How to take Nux vomica-Homaccord

Do not share medicines prescribed for you with any other person.

Always take Nux vomica-Homaccord exactly as your doctor has instructed you. You should check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are unsure.

The usual dose is:

Adults: Take 10 drops 3 times daily.

Hold in mouth 10-15 seconds before swallowing. In acute disorders, take 10 drops every 15 minutes for 8 doses.

Long-term administration of this preparation (for several months) must be supervised by a therapist.

Children and infants: Half the adult dose. The drops may be taken in a little water.

It is recommended not to eat or drink 15 minutes before or after taking the medication.

If you take more Nux vomica-Homaccord than you should:

Ingestion of the whole contents of this bottle by a child could result in alcohol intoxication.

Treatment is symptomatic.

In the event of overdosage, consult your doctor or pharmacist. If neither is available, seek help at the nearest hospital or poison control centre.

If you forget to take Nux vomica-Homaccord:

Do not take a double dose to make up for forgotten individual doses.

5. Possible side effects

Nux vomica-Homaccord can have side effects.

None known.

Not all side effects reported for Nux vomica-Homaccord are included in this leaflet. Should your general health worsen while taking this medicine, please consult your doctor, pharmacist or other healthcare professional for advice.

If you notice any side effects not mentioned in this leaflet, please inform your doctor or pharmacist.

6. Storing and disposing of Nux vomica-Homaccord

Keep all medicines out of the reach and sight of children.

- Store in a cool (below 25 °C) place.
- Replace cap tightly.

30 ml brown dropper bottles.
